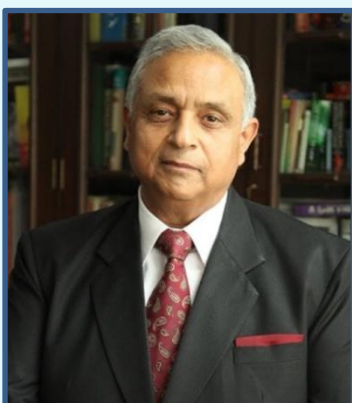

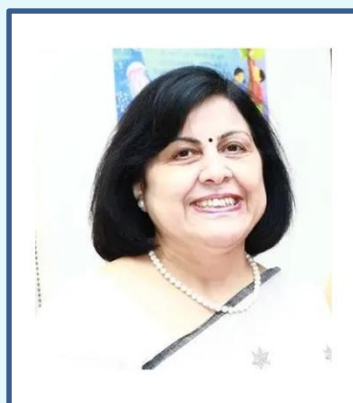

# **Admission Information**

## **INFORMATION FOR ADMISSION INTO NURSERY AND CLASS LKG 2026-27:**

For the entry class i.e **Nursery & LKG**, children whose date of birth falls between the following dates **only** are eligible for registration for the **academic session 2026-27**:

**i) Nursery: 01/04/2022 to 31/08/2023 (Both days inclusive)**

**ii) LKG: 01/04/2021 to 31/08/2022 (Both days inclusive)**

Birth certificate in original from the Registrar of Births & Deaths is essential at the time of admission for verification.

(In urban areas, Health Officer of the Corporation/Municipality/NAC concerned is designated as "Registrar of Births & Deaths". Similarly, in rural area, the Health Officer of the Concerned Public Health Centre is designated as "Registrar of Births & Deaths".)

- The applicants belonging to the Disadvantaged Group and Weaker section are required to register on the Govt. Portal [www.rteparadarshi.odisha.gov.in](http://www.rteparadarshi.odisha.gov.in), for admission.
- Applicants for the General Category, staff & Alumnus can apply online. They are required to remit an amount of **Rs 1000/-** online through **Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking**.
- Special Category: Admission under the special category would be made as per the government guidelines and instructions for the session 2026-27.

Documents required for submission by applicants from the Disadvantaged Group (SC/ST/SEBC-Non-Creamy Layer) & Economically Weaker Section:

(i) Original and attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by competent authority.

(ii) Identity proof/Address proof of Parents/Guardians (Aadhaar card/Driving License/Voter Id/KCC Card/electricity bill/water bill/Gas connection bill which is not more than 3 months old/Passport/PAN Card/MNREGA job card/Photo attested by any Gazetted officer/Certificate in support of Address given by the Sarpanch/Counsellor/Corporator/Local MLA/Gazetted Officer written on their Letterhead)

- Any poverty alleviation card issued by the Govt./Certificate of income issued by the competent authority in case of EWS candidates.
- Disability Certificate for children with disabilities (not less than 40%)
- CWC certificate in case of orphan issued by competent authority/CWC
- Aadhar Number of the child is essential for admission.
- After submission of application through the online portal, parents and/or guardians of eligible students need to visit the office of the Block Education Officer (BEO), Bhubaneswar along with original copies of necessary documents. The BEO will validate the application and forward it to the directorate of Elementary Education through the portal.
- Candidates will be allotted seats in different schools through online lottery considering their priority & category as per the policy of the government.

**N.B: 1. Registration fee is not refundable.**

**2. The number of applicants is usually more than the number of seats available. Therefore, if a candidate is unable to secure a seat, it is in no way a reflection of his/her calibre.**

**Admission Parameters in Consonance with School Policy and Guidelines of RCFCE Act, 2009.**

• General Category	65%

**N.B. Any applicant desirous of availing admission under more than one of the above categories/subcategories shall submit separate Registration form for each of the categories to be considered there by.**

**If the number of applicants exceed the number of seats available, admission will be done by Random Selection (Draw of Lots).**

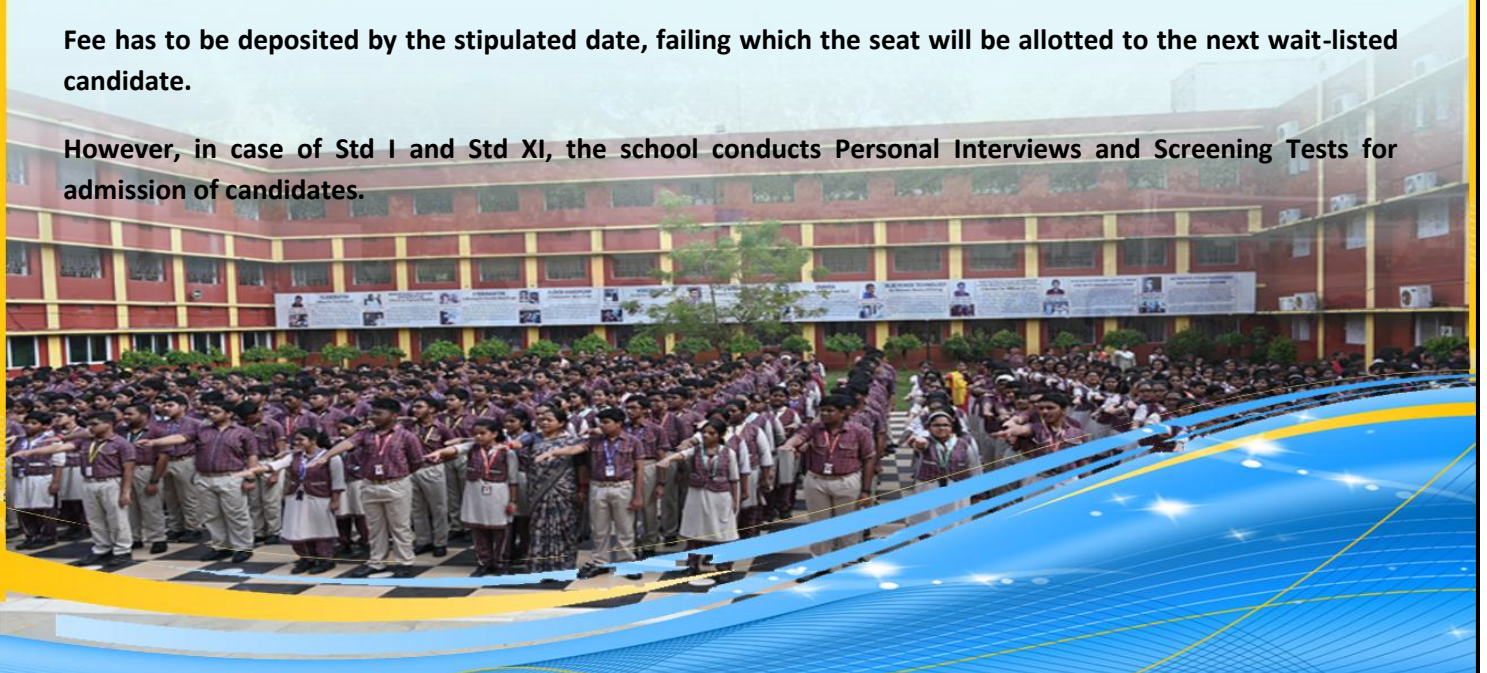
**General Directive for Selection: the list of selected candidates will be placed in the public domain (School Notice Board/Website).**

## **Admission into Other Classes:**

Forms will be issued to the applicant provided there is vacancy. Priority shall be given to applicants whose parent gets a transfer from outstations. Presence of parents (father and mother) is essential at the time of admission. Transfer certificate obtained from the previous school duly countersigned by the District Education Officer of Schools/ Dy. Director of Education / Regional Officer of authentication shall be verified.

Fee has to be deposited by the stipulated date, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next wait-listed candidate.

However, in case of Std I and Std XI, the school conducts Personal Interviews and Screening Tests for admission of candidates.
